

Terms of Reference

Video editor | FAIR SHARE of Women Leaders

Overview

FAIR SHARE of Women Leaders is a feminist initiative advocating for gender equality in the civil society sector. We do this in two ways:

- We [monitor](#) the proportion of women in the top leadership of civil society organisations and encouraging organisations to commit to gender equality in their leadership by 2030
- We develop and promote [Feminist Leadership](#) as a tool for individuals and organisations to transform their approach to leadership

To support the project ‘Feminist Leaders for Change’ in cooperation with the [Heinrich Böll Foundation](#), we now seek a video editor to support us through November 2022.

Scope of work

Tasks will evolve as the project progresses, but a key first project will be the following: In October 2021, we plan to host ‘8 weeks of Feminist Leadership,’ a free and public webinar series examining different aspects of Feminist Leadership. To promote this campaign, we would like to create a video using material from the [Feminist Leadership Project](#), a library of video interviews with feminist leaders from the social impact sector.

The video editor would:

- Bring together clips selected by the FAIR SHARE team
- Create new graphic title/informational slides
- Create subtitles in English
- Select appropriate music
- From the final product, create a 1-minute ‘trailer’ for social media

There may also be the possibility to create a second video with highlights from the webinars. Additional, related projects TBD.

Collaboration

Our working style is collaborative in nature; we value input from the people we work with. We would therefore appreciate if you are interested in not only implementing requests and tasks, but also thinking along with creatively with us.

Timeline

This contract would start as soon as possible and run until 30 November 2022. Please note the delivery date for the video task outlined above is **Monday August 2, 2021**.

Please send a (brief) proposal, budget, and a link to your portfolio/examples of your work to Sophia Seawell (sophia@fairsharewl.org) by **Monday 5 July**. The budget should include both an hourly rate as well as an estimate for the first project outlined above in total.

We aim to build a diverse team of people working with FAIR SHARE, and strongly encourage applications from women, particularly women of colour, women with disabilities, or women otherwise particularly underrepresented in the field.
